

I want to remind our citizens of the current noise ordinance. Please take the time to read it.

The first section is listed below:

UNREASONABLE NOISE PROHIBITED (SEC. 8.02.001)

The creation of any unreasonable, loud, disturbing, and unnecessary noises in the city is hereby prohibited. Noises of such character, intensity, and duration as are reasonably calculated to be detrimental to the life or health of any ordinary reasonable person are hereby prohibited. (1978 Code, ch. 6, sec. 8(A))
